Use this guide to duplicate the fabric placement in the 76" x 83" Large Quilt featured in Robert Kaufman's July 2021 Release.

Making the Plants

Use the TEN-1073-54 Ten Square pack, which includes 54 different Kona Cotton Solid squares, 10" x 10" each.

6 squares (Fabric 1 - Fabric 6) will be used to make five blocks for each of the nine columns (A - I) in the quilt. Refer to the fabric chart to identify which fabric is which and make one set of blocks (one each of Aloe, Prickly, Jade, Flower, and Cactus) for each column.

Plant Pot Cutting Guide

Making the Plant Pots

The five plant pots in each of the nine columns (A - I) are made with a Kitchen Window Wovens fat quarter (nine total fat quarters). Refer to Page 23 of the pattern, the cutting guide on this page, and the fabric chart to cut five each of pieces 6A and 6B from the appropriate fat quarter for each column.

Background Fabric

Use Essex Yarn-Dyed linen blend in Cinnamon and cut the background fabric exactly as described in the pattern.
