Use this guide to duplicate the fabric placement in my sample guilt.

The Pineapple and Leaf fat quarters I used are Robert Kaufman fabrics including Essex Yarn-Dyed (YD) linen blend, Kona Solids, and my Kitchen Window Wovens.

My background fabric is Essex Yarn-Dyed Speckle in Flax.

The pattern describes sorting the fat quarters into 7 sets, each including 3 fat quarters for the pineapples and 1 fat quarter for the leaves. The swatches on this page shown my sets, which I've labeled A - G.

Follow the pattern directions to make 6 blocks each from sets A, B, D, E, and F and 5 blocks each from sets C and G.



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
